Dr. Ruben Feldman Gonzalez is a paediatrician, neurologist, psychiatrist, writer and educator, a scientific visionary who has discovered an aspect of the human mind that he calls Unitary Perception. Permanent Candidate for the Nobel Peace Prize. Medical Surgeon and paediatrician in California, Florida, Pennsylvania, Indiana, Argentina and Alaska. Trained by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology -ABPN. Professor of Medicine (Child Psychiatry) in the University of Miami, Florida. Postgraduate Professor of Psychology in UABC, Mexicali, Mexico. Associate Professor of Psychology and Psychiatry in the IAS-RSM-Europe. Founding President of the IAS- RSM- Mexico (first branch outside of Europe).

From 1978 to the present, Dr. Ruben Feldman Gonzalez has taken at least two months per year to present his discoveries in Unitary Perception, in universities and centres of investigation all over the world. - To prevent the mixing of the actual language of Holokinetic Psychology with earlier contributions from psychology.

7. The experiment of Einstein-Podolsky-Rosen. Experiment with Wistar type rats.
8. We are all one.

10. What is not Unitary Perception (comparative picture). Do not mix languages.
11. Questions to the teacher. Summary. Change of roles (the students teach)

32 participants attended this workshop.

Two came from Leon-Guanajuato and plan to invite Prof. RFG to hold a workshop there as well as starting study groups and dialogues about Unitary Perception. The psychologist of the university of Guadalajara Juan Pablo Fajardo Gallardo passed the written exam with 9.9 points, which makes him an Associate Professor in Holokinetic Psychology of the International Academy of Sciences-RSM Mexico. Juan Pablo plans to initiate fraternal groups of exploration into what Unitary Perception is and what it is not in Guadalajara city, Jalisco.

How to organise a local workshop

Dear Friend,

We organised four workshops in Nicaragua in July 2005, each with more than 75 participants. I believe that the success was due to the team that was formed even though at the start we had problems, we clarified the situation that each one of us must work equally and in the end things went better.

- 1) There were four different cities, one seminar in each city, we looked for someone who could be made responsible for organising a seminar in their city.
- 2) We divided the travel expenses of Dr. Ruben, which amounted to one thousand dollars, amongst the four of us and we paid for this two months in advance.
- 3) We liased with the mayor of each city so that they would pay for the hotel or premises where the seminar was to take place. Then we had to sell them the idea, "that a scientist, candidate for the Nobel Prize of Peace etc. was visiting our city, and that in exchange for their economic kindness, we would organise teams of ten or twelve people to assist at the seminar, and we'd call it a deal. The four mayors accepted our idea and were even a little inclined towards a second visit of Dr. Ruben.(Each one of these mayors named him guest of honour in their respective cities with delivery of local government documents and media facilities.
- 4) To pay for the travel expenses we sold coupons to our friends/acquaintances/interested parties to a value of thirty dollars if they enrolled two months before the seminar. After the deadline, the coupon cost fifty dollars, but we also set up another promotion, that if three people subscribed to the same pass they (so they had to be friends or acquaintances), paid only one hundred dollars, that is to say, it worked out at 33.33 dollars each and we found that this worked well for us too.
1. Dr. RFG does not charge for his teaching of the Workshop.
- 5) Another way of attracting people to the seminar was to put them in charge of the coffee, biscuits, water or tea; and to guarantee these things at break-time we gave them two coupons. This included serving and tending to the coffee with milk that Dr. Ruben has only once in the day.
- 6) Another way to minimise costs is to look for people to invite Dr. Ruben to lunch but here you have a have a good plan so that they don't hinder Dr. Ruben's break. If it is possible, the host should go too so that no abuse of the situation takes place and so that the meal doesn't turn into a free medical consultation with prescription, lock, stock and barrel.
- 7) So the co-ordinators of the four cities came to a compromise and this served well, in the case of a loss, the coordinators of the cities would assume 50% and the national coordinator 50%.

In the end we had a small amount left over after covering all the overheads from rent of vehicles, to food and other expenses, which we distributed in the following way, 40% co-ordinator of the city.

40% national co-ordinator
20% Dr. Ruben or AIS-RSM-Mexico

But I personally believe that the most useful thing was that there were people present who attempt to live in Unitary Perception.

Finally, I don't know how much money Dr. Ruben brought home but his wife Cecilia wrote to me to ask if I could explain why her husband brought extra money; and how much of it was his! I recall that I said to her according to my understanding, the money of the AIS was for the exams which were 600 dollar sand that the rest was his.

I am here to serve you, and that is the most relevant thing.
